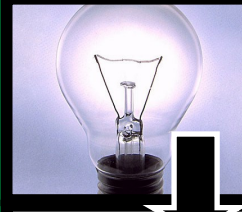

According to a Freedom of Information Request made by the UKRPA to the Crown Prosecution Service in 2015, around **1,500 individuals**

are charged with gas/electricity theft per year. The UKRPA is working to ensure this number is higher.
